

Teit Ethiopia Supplementary Fire Safety Procedure

Please follow these:

- Check fire instructions in your classroom.
- If not clearly displayed, ask the coordinator who will explain how to exit the building.
- Point out the fire exits each time there is a new learner in the class.
- Practice a fire drill at least once a year. Each group may walk through a fire practice on their own with their teacher before the whole school tries it together.
- Landlords may run practice fire alarm at any time and your group should know the procedures.

What to do when the fire alarm goes off

- Call the children/young people to silence and tell them to stand up.
- Tell them to stop what they are doing, leave their coats, bags and leave the building by the safest route.
- Tell them to walk fast but not to run. When you practice, decide who is going to lead the group: an adult and/or two responsible children/young people,
- Pick up the register and a pen and follow the learners out of the building.
- Take the children/young people to the assembly point in the designated place. This will usually be one that has been set by the mainstream school.
- Take the register again.
- If any children/young people are missing, tell the coordinator or head teacher, who will inform the fire brigade.
- Keep children/young people quiet, safe and lined up until you are told it is safe to return to the building. Do not let any child/young person go home alone.
